

Activity Instructions - Unit 5 Lesson 2

Supplies:

- Printed activity sheet (pages 2-5), pencil, device for accessing Google Earth, a globe or world map

Directions:

1. Print the activity pages you want to use. There are 12 buildings listed on pages 2-4, so you can decide how much time to spend on this activity. Use page 5 if you want to find your own locations.
2. Option 1: [Follow this link to find a list in Google Earth](#) with links to a Street View location of each building listed on the activity pages.
3. Option 2: Go to earth.google.com and type the location into the search bar, and then drag the Street View icon in the lower right-hand corner on to a street in front of the building.
4. Option 3: Print only activity page 5 and fill in your own locations. You can look for buildings with columns in your home town or look for examples on the Internet.
5. For Options 1 and 2, try finding each country on a globe or world map, too.
6. Look at the columns on each building and circle the type you see. Sometimes you will see more than one type on the same building!

Discussion questions:

1. What is each building used for? Does the type of column match the purpose of the building? Why or why not?
2. Which is your favorite type of column? Which of the buildings you saw did you like the best?
